- Registration closes at 11 a.m. SHARP! No late-comers will be allowed on show field.
- All pre-registered vehicles must arrive on the field by 11 a.m. to receive solid brass-etched dash plaque awards. *Pre-registration tickets will not be mailed to registrants.* Tickets will be distributed on site the day of the show.
- Pre-registration does not guarantee a reserved place at the show; first-come, first-served rule applies.
